Golconda fort

GOLCONDA FORT

Golconda fort was previously called Monkal and was built by Rajah of Warangal of Kakatiya in 1143 as a part of their western defenses along the line of the Kondapalli fort.

The city and the fortress were built on a granite hill that is 120m high, surrounded by massive battlements. The fort was rebuilt and strengthened by Rani Rudrama Devi and her successor Prataparudra. Later the fort came under the control of the Musunuri Nayakas, who defeated the Tughlaq's army occupying Warangal. It was ceded by Muhammad Kutub Shah to the Bahmani Sultanate as part of treaty in 1367. Under the Bahmani Sultanate, Golconda slowly rose to prominence. Sultan Quli Qutub-ud-Daula (1497-1512), son of Bahmani as a governor at Golconda, established the city as the seat of his gov around 1501. Bahmani rule gradually weakened during this period and Sultan Quli formally became independent in 1518, establishing the Qutb Shahi dynasty based in Golconda. Over a period of 62 years, the most fort was expanded by the 1st three Qutb Shahi sultans into the present structure, a massive fortification of granite extending around 5 km in circumference. It remained the capital of the Qutb Shahi dynasty until 1590 when the

Rachakonda fort

RACHAKONDA FORT

It was built by Recherla Singha king Anafalanayaka in the 14th century AD. It was completed in 1360 AD. The fort was the capital of the Rachakonda region. Recherla Singha Nayak was from Padma Nayaka dynasty, the region and fort were first ruled by K. Padma Nayaka, Bahmani sultans, Qutub Shahi and finally by Nizam.

HISTORY OF THE FORT

The history of the Rachakonda dates back to 14th century, when the fort was constructed as a capital of Rachakonda region by Recherla Singama Nayak belonging to Padma Nayaka dynasty. These Velama kings were chieftains of Kakatiya rulers but declared themselves independent after decline of Kakatiya dynasty in the beginning of the 14th century AD. It was said that the last king of Rachakonda from Recherla clan, Sarvasaya Singha Bhadrappa III was a highly accomplished scholar and learned person and had patronized famous Telugu poets like Lakkama Pothana & Srinatha. Eventually Rachakonda region was captured by Bahmani rulers in 1493. In 1518, it became a province of the sultans

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Bhongir fort

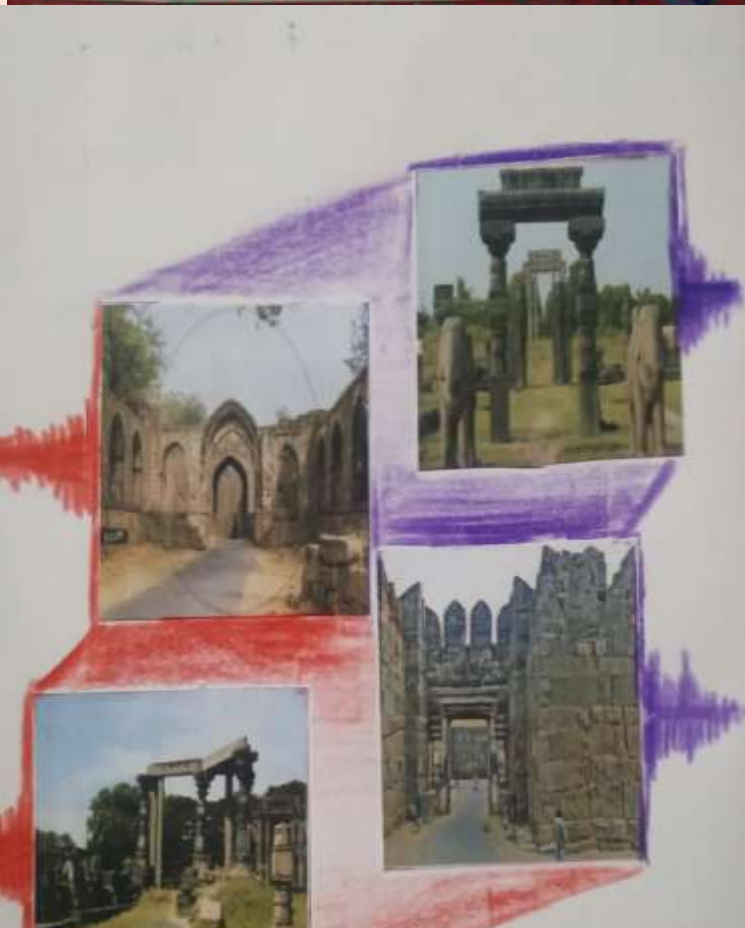
BHONGIR FORT

Bhongir or Bhuvanagiri fort is located in Bhuvanagiri Taluk, Bhuvanagiri district of Telangana. This fort was made by Huga Utkramaditya during reign of Huga & triangular dynasty of western Chalukya dynasty. Later it was renovated and ruler by Muhammad Nayak. It is located on a huge rock at a commanding height.

HISTORY

The fort adorns the place from the time it was built in 10th century. Bhongir fort was built on an isolated, inaccessible rock by the Western Chalukya ruler Tribhuvanamalla Utkramaditya VI in the year 1076 and was then named after him as Tribhuvanagiri. Later it was called Bhuvanagiri. Some of the inscriptions found in the fort were Kannada & Telugu language highlighting the lifestyle of the people of that era. The inscriptions, the architecture and some art sculptures found in the fort reveal that the fort was ruled by the Chalukya dynasty for a long time and then by the Kakatiya dynasty. The stone wall, the steps through the granite archway and the crumbling stone ruins on the later age still adorn the place.

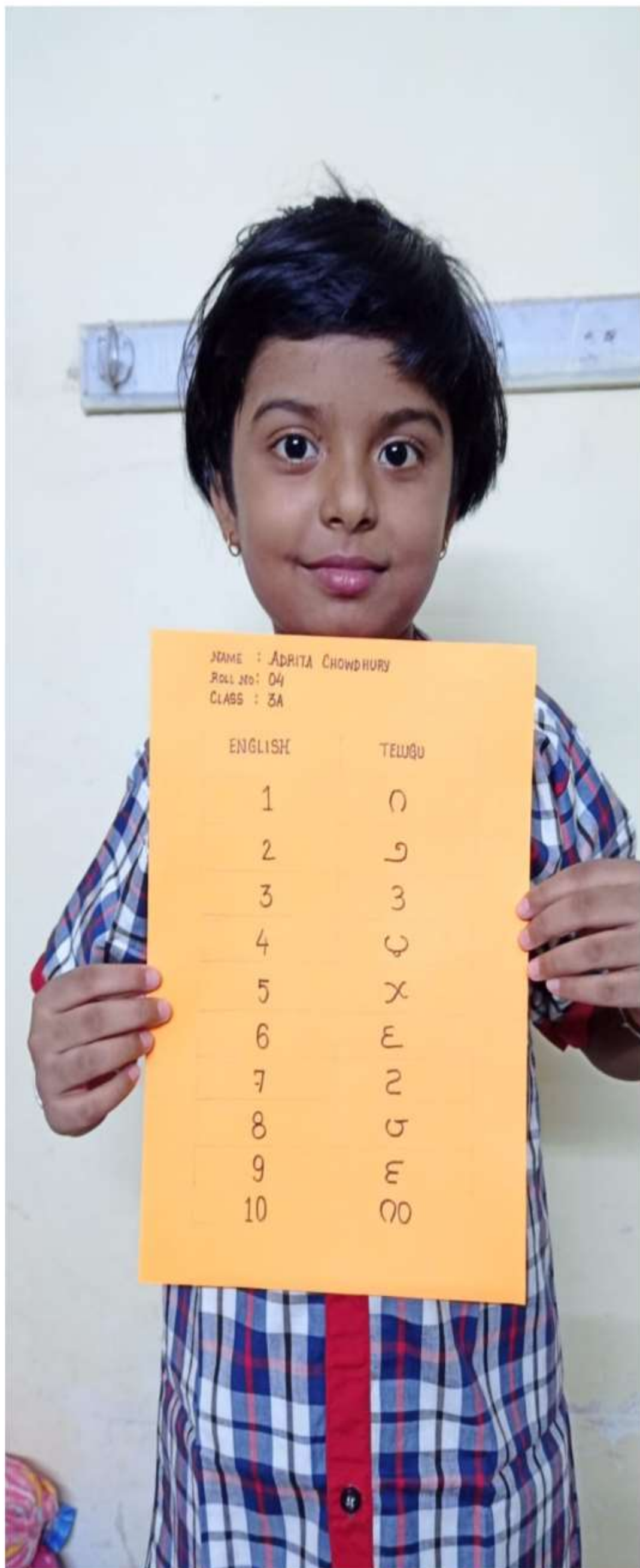
